Ambassadors of reconciliation

2 Corinthians 5:20

All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: Be reconciled to God

Here are the key points I am going to make in the sermon:

1. the mission of an ambassador to represent and reflect country's values.
2. the message of an ambassador comes straight from the president

We are ambassadors of the message of reconciliation.

1. the role of repentance and forgiveness in leading to reconciliation.
2. Important for us to know that God wants to do more than forgive us but to be reconciled to us (deeper and personal relationship)
3. To better understand the role of Jesus in reconciliation
4. To understand the centrality of reconciliation in sharing the gospel with others.
5. To understand that while reconciliation may not always be possible between two people, by trusting God we can participate in helping that person we have forgiven (yet estranged from), to experience reconciliation with God as well.
